Students not majoring in the College of Business may earn an accounting minor by completion of 15 semester hours of coursework:

I. Required courses:

ACC 1100	Principles of Accounting I	3 s.h.
ACC 2110	Principles of Accounting II (Prerequisite: ACC 1100 with a minimum grade of C-)	3 s.h.

II. Plus three (3) of the following suggested courses: 9 s.h.

ACC 3100	Intermediate Accounting I (Prerequisite: a minimum grade of C- in ACC 2110)
ACC 3110	Intermediate Accounting II(W) (Prerequisite: a minimum grade of C- in ACC 3100)
ACC 3200	Cost Accounting (Prerequisite: a minimum grade of C- in ACC 2110)
ACC 3560	Accounting for Non-Profit Organization (Prerequisite: a minimum grade of C- in ACC 2110)
ACC 3580	Individual Income Taxation (Prerequisite: a minimum grade of C- in ACC 2110)
ACC 4550	Intermediate Accounting III(W)(S) (Prerequisites: a minimum grade of C- in ACC 3110; senior standing)

Total: 15 s.h.

Students are advised to take all 1000/2000-level courses prior to the 3000-level courses in the minor. Students not admitted to the College of Business may take at most five business courses at the 3000 or 4000 level (unless more is required by a business minor or non-business major). Students must meet all eligibility requirements to take 3000-4000 level business courses. **A minimum overall GPA of 2.0 is required for the courses included in the minor.**
