Students not majoring in the College of Business may earn an entrepreneurship minor by completing the following 15 hours of coursework:

I. Required courses (12 hours):

ACC 1050 Survey of Accounting
BUS 1050 Introduction to Business
MGT 3060 Understanding Entrepreneurship
MGT 4650 New Venture Creation

II. One Elective course (3 hours):

Any 3000 or 4000-level College of Business course (excluding credit for instructional assistance) including but not limited to:

MGT 3170 Fostering and Managing Creativity
MGT 3190 International Entrepreneurship

If the student selects as an elective a 3000 or 4000-level College of Business course that requires one or more prerequisites, it is the student's responsibility to fulfill this additional requirement. **A minimum overall GPA of 2.0 is required for the courses included in the minor.**
